Dear Parents/Carers

I hope you have had a lovely half term break with your families.

Working At Assessments

KS3 Students will be sitting their end of year Working At (WA3) Assessments in all their subjects during assessment fortnight (**Monday 20**th **June – Friday 30**th **June)**. This may take the form of a test/exam or an assessed piece of writing/practical piece of work.

Students will be provided with revision material such as their Knowledge Organiser and revision lists giving details of the topics and content that will be tested. We are also encouraging students to take their workbooks home to revise. It is important that students look after their workbooks and check they have the correct books that are needed for the following day when packing their bags for school each evening. The expectation is that students spend time each evening preparing for the assessments. Constant revision and practice is the surest way to fully embed skills and knowledge required to secure excellent achievement at KS4.

All tests will be classroom based and undertaken under exam conditions. It is important that students are used to working under these conditions so they are fully prepared for their examinations at KS4. Students are expected to be fully prepared for all assessments with the **correct equipment** which includes:

- Pen
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Eraser
- Pencil sharpener
- Pencil case
- Scientific calculator
