I hope you are well. We have had another busy yet productive week.

I am delighted to share our **Keeping on Track (KOT) Report for SIAMS (Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools)**. As a Church school we are inspected by Ofsted and SIAMS. SIAMS being the 'faith inspection'. Just as Ofsted has a framework to follow so do Church schools. Whilst we are not in the window for a SIAMS inspection yet we do however have to have Keeping on Track monitoring visits. This is where an inspector comes in to school and checks whether you are on track for a positive inspection and that you are fulfilling all the necessary criteria.

We had our KOT on the 25<sup>th</sup> April 2023 and we received the report this week. We are absolutely delighted with the report and the progress we have made. The students and staff were, as always, incredible and I am very proud of what has been achieved so far.

We are continually improving our provision and want to be the best we can be. It is however, nice to be formally recognised for all the great work that does go on.

## **Year 11 GCSE Exams**

Year 11 GCSE exams start on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> May and run for 5 weeks with the last full cohort exam (Science) taking place on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June.

Mr Koltan has written to parents separately with details of the scheduled revision sessions, our expectations of students and leaving arrangements. It is critical that Year 11 students are punctual to school during the exam period and fully equipped with all the required equipment including a scientific calculator.

As we have communicated previously, Year 11 should be spending a significant amount of time each evening and during half term revising. Form tutors have worked with students in designing revision timetables. It is important students use these to ensure they spend sufficient time revising all subjects examined.
