## **Dear Parents and Carers**

Thank you for your support with the reply slip and payment for your child. I hope they are looking forward to the visit and ask that you talk through the arrangements for the day with them. If you require any further information, please do not hesitate to contact me.

- Students do not need to wear school uniform; however, can I reinforce Mrs Scott-Herron's previous messages, that cycling shorts cannot be worn on non-uniform days.
- Arrival time at Warrington Cineworld (Time Square Unit 8, Warrington, WA1 2LH) from 9.15am, in readiness for registration, collection of refreshments and a 10am start time.
- Refreshments from the cinema cannot be purchased on the day.
- Once in the cinema, students will not be able to leave the building until the end of their film.
- Be aware that the length of each film varies (Super Mario Bros. 92mins, Transformers: Rise of the Beasts 120mins and Mission Impossible 163mins), meaning that some films will run past 12pm (the time that students will be dismissed from school).
- Students will be dismissed for the summer holidays directly from the cinema.

We appreciate students will be excited and may never have had the opportunity to visit the cinema with all of their friends, however, please can you remind them that they are representing the school at all times. Should students make poor choices, behaving inappropriately at any time during the event, then we will have no choice but to remove them from the film and contact parents/carers for support.
