Can we also request that students do not arrive in vehicles that purposefully backfire as this has previously frightened smaller children and disturbed hotel guests.

The cost of the Prom is £34 and this includes the full prom package with no extra cost. Please make contact if you would like to pay in instalments or if you need any support. Payment is non-refundable; thus, it is essential to confirm your child's commitment to attending before making the payment.

To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all attendees, we kindly ask you to let us know of your child's dietary requirements and any special arrangements needed to ensure they can attend. The meal is a set menu, however vegetarian and gluten free options will be available.

Please be aware that your child's participation in the event is determined upon them maintaining good behaviour in school and following our High Expectations, High Aspirations and High Standards every day. This includes good attendance, being punctual to school and lessons and consistently adhering to the school polices and procedures, especially the uniform policy: www.boteler.org.uk/uniform.
