TYN-Y-FELIN JUNE 2025 · 3 DAYS FOR YEAR 7 STUDENTS APPROXIMATELY £ 180




DISNEYLAND, PARIS

- Criteria for attending a Rewards trip (subject to change):
- Having no attendance concerns related to unauthorised absence pushing to achieve the school target of:

 - A review of C3 and truancy incidents
 - o No serious incident behaviour logs e.g. suspensions


ITALY - BAY OF NAPLES
