The visit would cost in the region of £2,595 and flights are expected to be from Manchester. The costs would include flights, transfers, accommodation, breakfast, the evening meal at the Hotel and all the activities. An initial deposit of £250 would be needed, with another £250 payment 6 weeks later. The balance would need to be paid by 26^{th} March 2026. If the cost is worrying you.
